Originally a 1920's Standard Oil Station, the existing Dairy Queen was demolished to make way for a new Dairy Queen - Orange Julius. Located across from the Minnehaha Park in Minneapolis, the franchisee, the second generation owner, wanted to increase sales by expanding the size and menu. Opening in the fall of 2009, Wilkus Architects worked closely with the owner/franchisee, city of Minneapolis and the corporate office to ensure the final design and function met the needs and expectations of all three.
